

Transportation to Taste of Colorado Festival

Taste of Colorado is fast approaching, and we cannot wait to celebrate all things Colorado! From a local music lineup with twice the number of stages, to over 50 marketplace and food vendors, and a kid zone with fun activities, there is something for everyone to enjoy and experience at the festival!

Taste of Colorado will be held at Civic Center Park from September 3-5, 2022. While driving to the event is an option, here is a list of some alternative transportation modes to consider that could save you a few bucks at the pump and time circling the blocks for a parking spot.

RTD:

- Rail: With stops at Union Station and Theater District/Convention Center Station, rail takes you close to the action and leaves you a quick walk or 16th Street MallRide* away from the festival. To plan your rail trip, visit the [RTD Trip Planner](#) site.
- Bus: Many of the metro's buses travel through downtown and have stops that will take you close to Civic Center Park. To plan your bus trip, visit the [RTD Trip Planner](#) site.

Bicycle:

Throw on your helmet and ride along one of [Denver's many bikeways](#) to get to the festival! While bicycles are not allowed within the festival grounds, u-racks located at the Denver Public Library, the McNichols Building, the Wellington Webb Building, and Acoma Plaza at the Denver Art Museum help get you right to the entrance of the event!

Scooter and Bike Share:

Don't own a bike or scooter? Not a problem! Download the Lyft or Lime app and take an e-bike or scooter to Civic Center Park. Just remember to park responsibly and in places that do not obstruct pedestrian ways or vehicular traffic.
